Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (1) Dollars, in hand paid by said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, grants, bargain, and sell unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described lot, piece, or parcel of land, situated in the County of Baldwin and State of Alabama, and known and described as follows, to wit:-

Lot Ten (10) in Block twenty one (21) in town of Silverhill. And the said Oscar T. Johnson party of the first part, for his heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant promise and agree, to and with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that he has not done, or suffered to be done, anything whereby the said premises hereby granted are, or may be, in any manner encumbered or charged; and that the said premises, against all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same, by, through or under he will Warrant and Forever Defend. And the said party of the first hereby expressly waive and release any and all right, benefit, privilege and advantage, and exemption, under or by virtue of any and all Statutes of the State of Alabama, providing for the exemption of homesteads from sale on execution or otherwise.
