Using My Tree Tags

In November, the Society welcomed Jennifer McDonald, who spoke to us on the topic of how we can use the Tree Tags in Ancestry



to help us with our genealogy research. Jennifer is currently working toward becoming a certified genealogist.

The following are some notes from her presentation:

First, you must add your family tree to Ancestry.

Ancestry - Develop relationship tags With tags, one can make note of who adopted into family or adopted out of the family. Life Experience Tags:

DNA Tags – can notate which are matches to you.




- Common DNA Ancestor
- DNA Connection
- DNA Match

Research Status Tags:

- Can mark those you are actively researching
- If you mark an ancestor as having a brick wall on them, someone who sees that and has information could contact to add information they have available.



- Complete
- Hypothesis Can record hypothesis when not confirmed by documentation.
- Unverified-have person in the tree, but do not have enough records to confirm
- Verified have done best to verify all info, done all research can possibly do



Relationships Tags:

- Adopted into this family
- Adopted out of this family
- Died young
- Direct ancestor
- Multiple spouses
- Never married
- No children
- Orphan

Custom Tags

- Divorced
- Occupation [*i.e.*, doctor]
- US Civil War [side fought for]
- US Navy service

Notes are private; Comments are public



When working on DNA, you want to become a manager of DNA results.

You can use an Excel spreadsheet instead of Ancestry. (She shared with us a sample of an Excel spreadsheet where she marked colorcoded cells next to name to represent relationship

- Go to Family Tree view
- Go to settings
- Go to Sharing Preferences and click on Changes
- When you add a person, you may choose between
- viewer,
- collaborator, or
- manager.
- Choose to be a manager.

Work off your second cousin list

Create custom groups -

ICW: In common with [name of cousin] DNA matching will show up adoptions.

If there is an in-family adoption, the DNA results will show that.

YouTube is an excellent source for how-to videos on how to use Ancestry.

Keywords: Ancestry DNA, Christopher Allen [get some links]

<u>Question</u>: Is there an index of codes for DNA matches?

<u>Answer</u>: No. make your own. [match your colors to FS color codes for lines]

You may indicate your sharing preferences for those with whom you wish to collaborate

Use FamilyTreenow.com to search for relationships https://www.familytreenow.com/

Ancestry DNA kits have a code, you can record the code to check on if you give a kit to someone else. Set yourself up to be the manager.
