Bylaws Revision Consideration

The Board of Directors is considering a change to the Bylaws of the Merced County Genealogical Society. The change would remove the office of President-Elect, reduce the number of Board members to seven and reduce the quorum required for Board Meetings to conduct business to four.

The President-Elect position was intended as a way for someone to spend time training with the current President and assume the Presidency when the current President leaves at the end of their elected term. Finding people able or willing to be President, even with a year of training, has been difficult. Also, having an even number of Board members can lead to tie votes and lacking a quorum of five at our last Board meeting caused us to have to reschedule the meeting in order to vote on the 2018 proposed budget and some other issues.

This proposal will be discussed at the next meeting on March 17th.
