The Society's Book Acquisition Committee buys mostly source books - vital records, court, land and probate, military service - for Selby's Genealogy Collection. The library concentrates more on "how-to-do-it" types for their own acquisitions. During the past three years, we have bought some 70 books and a few special maps. In addition, organizations such as the DAR and many members generously donate items such as family histories. In 2011, The library received 212 books bequeathed by one member Selby's collection now has an impressive 13,000 items, and unlike most libraries, you can actually check out quite a few where we have duplicates.
