The **Carolingian Dynasty** (known variously as the *Carlovingians* or *Karlings*); of or pertaining to the Frankish dynasty that reigned in France a.d. 751–987, first under Charlemagne, and in Germany until a.d. 911.

Dr. Stemper, a multi generational native of the region is a descendant of Emperor Charlemagne. He holds (PhD) degree from the University of Oxford.in Angelo - American Intellectual History. He is a Member of the Oxford University Strategic Studies Group and a Fellow of the Royal Society for the Promotion of Arts, Manufactures, and Commerce (Founded 1754) in London. He is Life Member of many lineage and hereditary orders and societies.
