The first telephone in Jasper County was installed in the store at Maxwell in the 1890's. According to <u>History of Jasper County, Georgia</u>, it was run from the Kelly store to the Planter's Warehouse in Monticello. The line was used by the cotton buyers to get the daily cotton prices which were telegraphed to Monticello.
