There is controversy over the origin of the name HANNON, some say that spelled that way with the double N indicates an Irish origin, while the HANON spelling indicates a Belgian origin. Some even say that the HANNONS emigrated from Ireland to Belgium and then to the U.S. Jamesalbert Hannon thinks that perhaps the Catholic Church in Weir or Scommon, Kansas where his grandfather Hannon made his First Holy Communion might have informations about the place of birth of his grandfather or at least the place where he was baptized in Belgium.
