The following facts and information subscribed and sworn to before me this date: _____

On September 17, 2002 at approximately 5:00 PM I, Deputy Josh Smith, was on duty for the Henry County Sheriff's Department, when I was dispatched to 8171 E 600S, Cambridge City, in reference to a vandalism.

Upon my arrival I spoke with the complainant, Ron Barnes, who informed me that sometime during the day a group, which is associated with some type of historical society came onto his property unauthorized. Mr. Barnes stated that he has an old cemetery, which is located on his property, just west of his residence. This group apparently went on his property and began removing rubbish and raking the area around the cemetery. Mr. Barnes stated that he had buckeye trees and daylilies planted in that area and the members of the group apparently removed those items and placed them in a pile. Mr. Barnes stated that no one, without obtaining permission first, is allowed on his property. I later informed the Barnes' to make contact with the Sheriff in the morning to see if he could inform them of any association, which may be doing this type of work in the area.
