A History of St. Joseph County, Indiana was authored by Timothy Edward Howard and was published in 1907 by the Lewis Publishing Company of Chicago and New York. On page 960 of that work there are biographies of some Denuat family members who were Doctors in St. Joseph County. In the biography for Matthew S. Denuat, M. D. you can read: "Only four children are now living: ... Dr. James L. is a leading medical practitioner of Hamlet, Indiana. The last named, after completing his literary training in the high schools of Canada, entered Rush Medical College of Chicago, from which he was graduated with the class of 1897, removing to Hamlet, Indiana, where he has since been numbered among its successful practitioners. He married Miss Cloe Fancher, a talented musician, by whom he has one daughter, Elizabeth. Dr. James L. Denaut is a Republican in his affairs." Cloe Fancher was the daughter of Jonathan Jr. and Margaret (Roe) Fancher.
