WHFREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there is now deposited in the Bureau of Land Management Warrant No. 87723, for one hundred twenty acres, in favor of Joseph Mullens, Private, Captain Moore's Company, Virginia Militia, War 1812, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the north half of the southeast quarter and Lot five of Section ten in Township seven south of Renge nineteen east of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Kansas, containing one hundred thirty-seven acres and ninety-seven hundredths of an acre, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land on file in the Bureau of Land Management; the said Warrant having been duly assigned to William Cummings, in whose favor said tract has been located:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said William Cummings, and to his heirs, the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said William Cummings, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

This patent is issued in lieu of one dated May 1, 1860, which has been canceled, because of an error in the description.
