KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11, 1847, Margaret Elisabeth Kuhn, Nother and heir at Law of Christopher Break, deceased, late a Private in Captain Jones Company, C. 19th Regiment, U. S. Infantry, having deposited in the Bureau of Land Management, a Warrant in her favor, numbered 75272, for 160 acres:

THERE IS, THEREFORE, GRANTED by the UNITED STATES, unto Washington Hays, assignee of Margaret Elizabeth Kuhn, and to his heirs, the following described land:

> Sixth Principal Meridian, Kansas. T. 7 S., R. 20 E., Sec. 7, SE4.

The area described contains 160 acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the Bureau of Land Management, which said Tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11, 1847. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Washington Hays, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

This patent is issued in lieu of one dated August 3, 1860, which has been canceled because it erroneously described the land as being the SW2 sec. 7.
