Vital records update

Unfortunately, there has been little movement on creating rules to implement the "new" vital records law. A rule making coordinator, Theresa Roberts, was hired late last fall. This editor sent her a copy of the proposed changes to chapters 4, 7, & 8 of the rules which were originally sent to

Elena Jellison (the now retired rule making coordinator) in November 2011. In early December (2012) Ms. Roberts sent this editor a draft of these chapters as revised by the Office of Data, Research and Vital Statistics. This draft combines chapters 4 & 8, resulting in much confusion about which rules apply to which category of vital records (open versus closed).

As of today (January 17) no meeting date has been set for the rule making committee. Veterans' graves inventory update

Senate president Kevin Raye submitted a resolve last legislative session (LD 1630): To Establish a Stakeholder Group for the Development of a Plan for the Inventory and Proper Care of Veterans' Graves.

The committee was formed in early September and met four times over the next four months. This editor, as legislative liaison for the Maine Old Cemetery Association and vice president (now president) of the Maine Genealogical Society, was a member of the committee.

The report of the committee is in its final draft stage and will be presented to the Joint Standing Committee on Veterans and Legal Affairs and the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government in the next few weeks. In summary, this report makes the following recommendations:

- 1. "Adopt a uniform maintenance standard for veterans' graves"
- 2. "Adopt a uniform minimum standard for the inventory/recording of veterans' graves"
- 3. "Clarify the fine assessment, collection and disbursement of fines for veterans' graves not properly maintained"
- 4. "Establish an education campaign on:

Proper care for veterans' graves Standardized inventory/recording of veterans' graves ordering VA headstones/medallions"

MOCA asks for two cemetery bills

At the request of the Maine Old Cemetery Association, Senator Thomas Saviello (R, Franklin County) has submitted two bills for the 126th legislative session. The first, co-sponsored by Representative Joan Welsh (D, Rockport), is titled *An Act to Prohibit the Placement of Political Signs Within 25 Feet of a Cemetery or Burial Ground*. The second bill has a tentative title of *An Act to Preserve and Protect Ancient Burial Grounds*. Neither bill has an LD number assigned, but that should happen shortly after the deadline to submit bills (January 18).

The bill on Ancient Burying Grounds may be controversial with possible push back from the Maine Municipal Association calling it an unfunded mandate. A publicity drive with supporting calls to legislators will be organized after the LD number is assigned.
