

The Dr. Nathan Thomas house is the only remaining Underground Railroad house left open for public tours in Michigan. It was built in 1835 a mile or so up the road from where it currnently is located. Dr. Thomas constructed a much larger home for his family on the original site where they lived out their remaining years.
