RIDENBAUGH** was born in June 1864 in Missouri.^{1,2,3} He appeared on the census in 1870 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.⁴ He appeared on the census in 1900 in Ketchikan, Alaska.⁵ He appeared on the census in 1910 in Boise, Ada County, ID.⁶ He died on June 17, 1935 in Boise, Ada County, ID.⁷

SECOND GENERATION

2. **William Fahnestock RIDENBAUGH**⁸ was born on February 19, 1821 in Bedford, PA.^{9,10,11} He was a printer and newspaper editor between 1843 and 1852 in Missouri.¹² He Political was prominent in Democratic politics between 1845 and 1874 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.¹³ He appeared on the census in 1850 in Buchanan County, MO.^{14,15} He was a Clerk of Buchanan County Circuit Court between 1852 and 1864 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.^{16,17} He Political was affiliated with democratic politics between 1855 and 1873 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.¹⁸ He was listed in Doniphan County, KS as land owner in 1856 in Doniphan County, KS.¹⁹ He Deed grantee on a warranty deed from Joseph B. Smith to William Ridenbaugh on April 16, 1856 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.²⁰ He Deed grantor on a warranty deed to Samuel S. Lungren on November 27, 1856 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.²¹ He City Directory as the circuit clerk, resides on 6th between Isadore and Robidoux in 1859/60 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.²² He appeared on the census in 1860 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.²³ He City Directory as the clerk of the Circuit Court and resides at corner of 6th & Robidoux in 1860 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.²⁴ He City Directory as residing at corner of 6th & Robidoux with mention of (IVR & Co) between 1867 and 1869 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.²⁵ He City Directory He is listed as residing at NE corner of 6th and Robidoux. in 1869/70 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.²⁶ He appeared on the census in 1870 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.²⁷ He was a Clerk of Buchanan County Circuit Court between 1870 and 1874 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.²⁸ He City Directory He is listed as residing at the NE corner of 6th and Robidoux. in 1871 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.²⁹ He City Directory He is the clerk of the circuit court and resides at the NE corner of 6th and Robidoux. in 1872 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.³⁰ He City Directory Clerk of Circuit Court residing at NE corner of 6th and Robidoux. in 1873 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.³¹ He City Directory He is listed as an American with 2 males and 2 females living with him at the NE corner of 6th & Rob in 1874/75 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.³² He died on October 18, 1874 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.^{33,34} He was buried about October 19, 1874 in Mt. Mora Cemetery, St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.³⁵ He Moved to St. Joseph in spring 1845 in Buchanan County, MO.³⁶ He was married to Hannah CREAL on December 22, 1847 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.^{37,38,39}

3. **Hannah CREAL** was born on March 19, 1829 in Ohio.^{40,41,42,43} She appeared on the census in 1850 in Washington township, Buchanan County, MO.⁴⁴ She appeared on the census in 1860 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.⁴⁵ She died on August 17, 1866 in St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.⁴⁶ She was buried on August 18, 1866 in Mt. Mora Cemetery, St. Joseph, Buchanan Co., MO.⁴⁷ Her funeral was held on August 18, 1866 in Methodist Episcopal Church.⁴⁸
