



SHORT HISTORY OF THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH BATAVIA, N. Y.



THE CHURCH AUDITORIUM

The fourth church established in the village of Batavia was of the Baptist denomination. Its predecessors were the First Presbyterian Church, which was the outgrowth of a Congregational Society, organized September 19th, 1809; the First Methodist Episcopal Church, organized December 15th, 1819, and St. James Protestant Episcopal Church, organized June 6th, 1815.

On November 19th, 1835, at a meeting held in the Genesee County Court House, at Batavia, at which Gideon Kendrick and P. S. Moffit presided, it was decided that a new church and P. S. Moffit, to be known as the "Baptist Society of Batavia Village," be formed, and Richard Covell, Jr., John Dorman, William Blossom, William D. Popple and Calvin Foster, were elected the first Trustees of the new society. Rev. Ichabod Clark was at once engaged as the first Pastor, and a house of worship was erected on Jackson Street, in the same year by T. J. Hoyt and Thomas McCulley, on land purchased from T. J. Hoyt and Thomas McCulley, on land purchased from William D. Popple for \$400.00. This edifice, the first ever occupied by the Baptist denomination in Batavia, was located on the lot now occupied by the New Family Theater, on the west side of Jackson Street. About 1865 this building was remodeled at a cost of \$10,000. In 1877 the Society was reorganized and incorporated under its present name.

The old church building was destroyed by fire, about 32 years ago, while occupied by the Salvation Army, as its meeting place, the Baptist denomination having removed to its present beautiful new church edifice in the fall of 1891, after which the lot remained unoccupied and fenced off for several years until it was sold by the Society to the predecessors of the Family Theater Corporation.

The Society having outgrown its old home, on Jackson Street, decided early in 1890 to erect a new building, and purchased from Mrs. Mary Douglass, for \$4,500.00, the lot on East Main Street, on which the present handsome church stands. The cornerstone of the new structure was laid June 17th, 1890, by the Rev. Cyrus A. Johnson, then Pastor of the Society, who remained as such for 16 years, and thereafter continued as Pastor Emeritus of the church, until his death a few years ago. The completed edifice, which cost about \$40,000.00, was dedicated October 22nd, 1891, the dedicatory sermon being preached by the Rev. J. A. W. Stewart, D.D., of Rochester.

During the dedicatory services the sum of \$7,000.00 was contributed to liquidate the indebtedness incurred by the Society in constructing its new home. From time to time the present house of worship has been altered and improved in diverse ways to modernize it and to afford accommodations for its constantly increasing membership. Originally the choir occupied a gallery above the pulpit; but this gallery was early discarded and removed, and the organ lowered to the level of the pulpit on its south side, where the choir is now stationed. 




