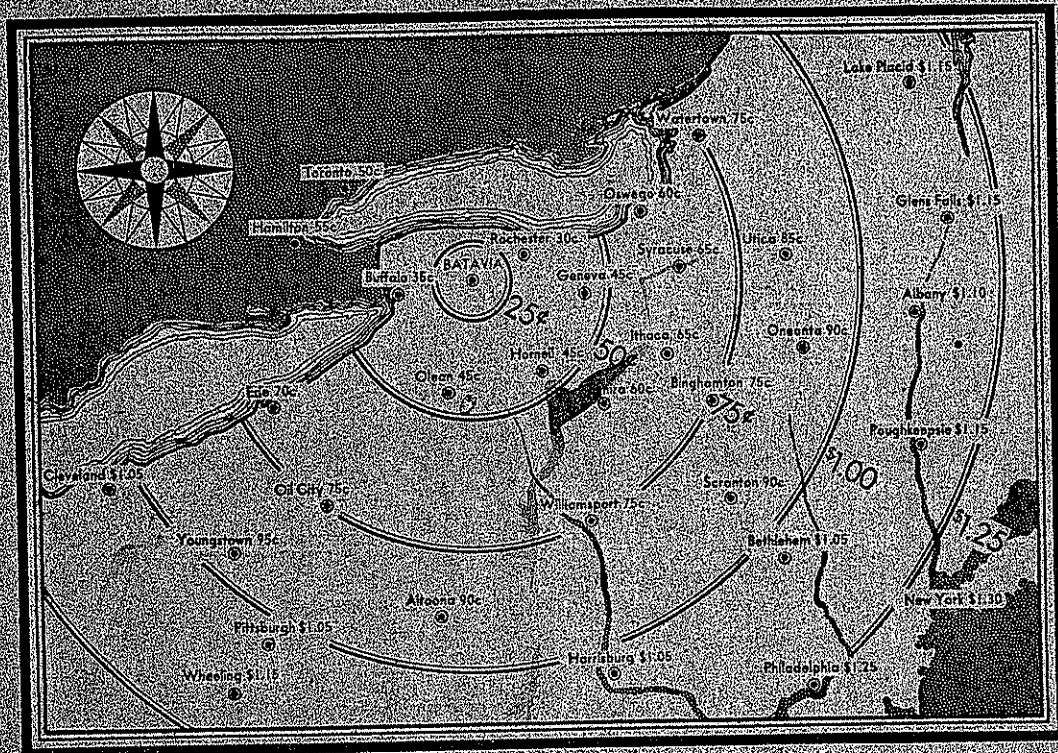

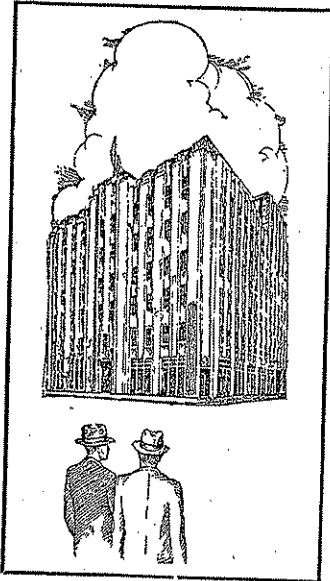

HOW TO TRANSACT BUSINESS WITH THE COMPANY

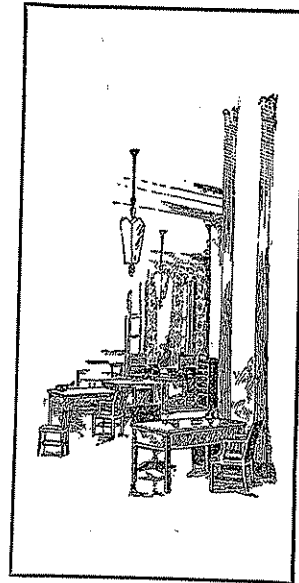
All matters relating to new telephone service, removals, termination of service, directory listings, advertising in the directory, adjustment of accounts, collection of bills, etc., are handled at our Business Office. The Business Office is located at 4 State Street, Batavia, N. Y.



Business hours are 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.; Saturday until 12 M. The offices are closed on Sundays and on generally observed legal holidays. In case of an emergency outside of office hours, call the operator and ask the Supervisor to assist you. There is no charge for telephone calls to Telephone Company official numbers listed in this directory.

Our aim is to render a service that will be satisfactory to our customers. We realize that difficulties will sometimes occur despite all our efforts to avoid them. On the preceding page of this directory are shown the telephone numbers which should be called to report service difficulties.

If your requirements are not fully met by calling as outlined there, call the Manager, Burt F. Disbrow, telephone Batavia Official 24.



Changes In Location—Discontinuance of Service

If you are moving to a new location, or wish your telephone equipment rearranged in any way, we can have the work done with the least inconvenience to you if you will give us at least ten days' advance notice. Similar notice should also be given if you wish your service discontinued, either permanently or temporarily.

Bills for Service

Bills for exchange service will be rendered monthly in advance for periods beginning with the date of the current bill. Charges for out-of-town calls and for additional local messages will appear on the same bill. However, the monthly period covered by these latter charges will end the day before the date of the current bill.

Directories

Every effort is made to improve each issue—to make it better than the last one. Sometimes, despite the care and attention given it, errors occur. You are, therefore, urged to verify your own listing immediately upon receipt of a new directory and to report any error to the Business Office.

Announcement is made in the public press a reasonable time in advance, of the closing time of each issue of this directory. Notification as to new listings, changes or corrections should be made to the Business Office.

If you have not received your copy of the latest issue of the Telephone Directory, or if you need additional copies of the directory you should call the Business Office.

Directories of other cities either in the territory of this Company or in other parts of the Bell System may be obtained at nominal cost by applying at your local Business Office. A list of out-of-town numbers frequently called will be furnished without charge.

Communication Services TO FIT YOUR PARTICULAR NEEDS

The New York Telephone Co. has a solution for your communication problem, whether it be in your business or at your home. A partial list of the many time saving and convenient facilities offered for your consideration is shown below.

TELEPHONE SYSTEMS for communication between different parts of the office, home or plant.

EXTENSION TELEPHONES in another part of the office or home.

SECRETARIAL EQUIPMENT for providing a means whereby an attendant may answer incoming calls on a number of lines when the called parties are absent.

TELEPHONE OUTLETS AND PORTABLE TELEPHONES for locations where permanently connected telephones are not required.

TELEPHONE TYPEWRITER SERVICE for instantaneous communication of typewritten messages between offices in the same building, in the same city or in different parts of the country.

LOUD RINGING BELLS for locations where noise makes it difficult to hear the ordinary telephone bell.

EQUIPMENT for the reception of telephone orders with speed and efficiency.

ESPECIALLY EQUIPPED TELEPHONES for those who have difficulty in hearing over an ordinary telephone.

Calls for nearby points should be made as described on Page 5. For other points, call Long Distance and give the operator the name of the point and the telephone number you wish to reach. If you do not know the number, it may be obtained by calling Information; or the call may be completed by giving the name and address to the Long Distance Operator.

Station-to-station calls are handled more rapidly and at lower rates than person-to-person calls. Reduced rates are generally in effect during evening and night periods. Charge is made if anyone at the called station answers.



Person-to-Person Calls

FOR A PARTICULAR PERSON



Call Long Distance and include with the details of your call the name of the particular person you wish to reach.

Person-to-person rates are somewhat higher than station-to-station rates, but no charge other than a report charge is made unless the desired person or private branch exchange extension station is reached. There is no reduction during evening and night periods.

Rates

For day rates on station-to-station calls to certain-frequently called points see page 7. For other rates call Long Distance.

On station-to-station calls to points in the United States and Canada where the day rate is more than 35c there are, with a few exceptions, rate reductions between 7:00 P.M. and 8:30 P.M., with further reductions between 8:30 P.M. and 4:30 A.M. Reduced rates do not apply on calls to Cuba, Mexico, South America or on Transoceanic and Ship-to-Shore Service.

For report charges which may apply on uncompleted person-to-person, appointment, messenger and collect calls, see table on page 6.

Collect Calls

Upon the request of the calling party, the charges on any call to points in the United States, Canada and Cuba may be reversed without additional charge (if the charge is accepted at the called station), except on a station-to-station call where the rate is 20c or less, in which case a somewhat higher rate will apply.

A report charge will apply if the call is not completed because the called party refuses to accept the charges.

The reversal of charges is not permitted on calls to points in Mexico, South America and on Transoceanic and Ship-to-Shore Service.

International and Ship-to-Shore Service

Telephone service is available to all points in Canada and Cuba, to important cities in Europe, Australia, Mexico and South America, and to certain large steamships while at sea and within

calling range. To place a call or obtain information regarding these services, call the Long Distance Operator. For rates to certain Transoceanic points see page 6.

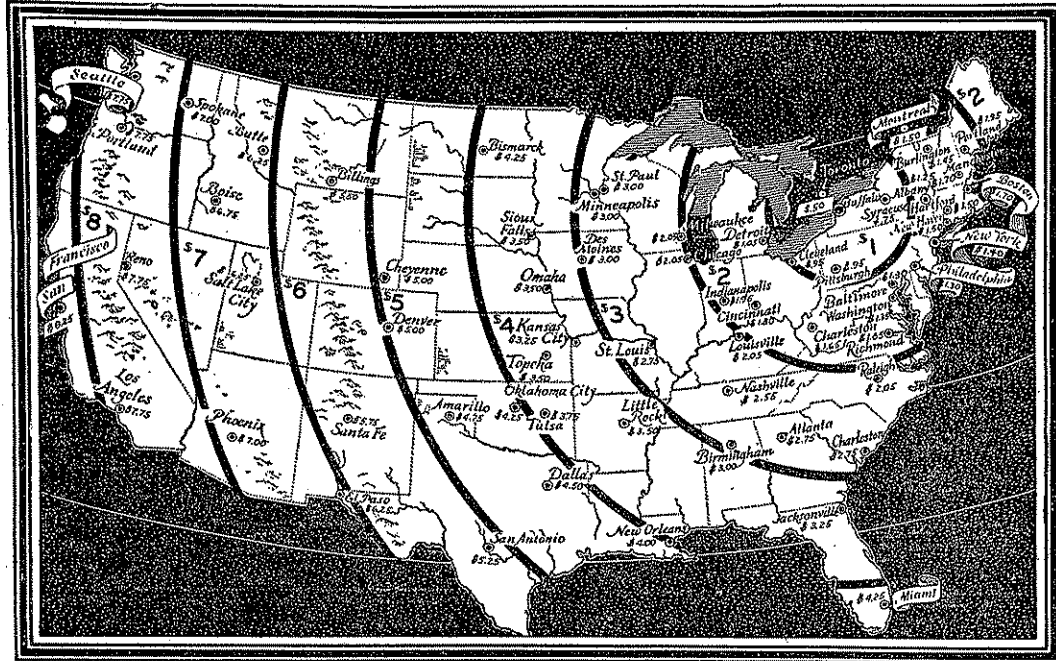

GENERAL INFORMATION

Telephone Directories

This telephone directory, issued by the New York Telephone Company free of cost, is and remains the property of the Telephone Company. It shall not be mutilated and is to be surrendered to the carrier who delivers the subsequent issue. No binder, holder or auxiliary cover, except such as may be furnished by the Telephone Company, shall be used in connection with any telephone directory furnished by the Telephone Company.

The Company assumes no liability for damages arising from errors or omissions in the making up or printing of its Directories except in the case of charge listings in connection with which its liability shall be limited to a refund at the monthly rate for each listing for the time an error or omission continues after reasonable notice in writing to the Company. The Company does not guarantee the permanency of telephone numbers assigned or to be assigned. If telephone numbers are displayed on stationery or in advertising, care should be exercised to show the correct numbers at all times.

Overtime Charges on Local Calls

In accordance with tariff provisions a "local message" is a connection on a local call five minutes or less in duration. Although it is not the Company's general practice to time all local messages as it is to time all out-of-town messages, overtime charges will be applied whenever local messages from a public telephone or a subscriber's message rate telephone are found to materially exceed five minutes in duration.

Telegrams by Telephone

You may telephone telegrams, cablegrams or radiograms to the Postal Telegraph-Cable Company or The Western Union Telegraph Company. The telegraph charges will appear on your monthly telephone bill.

You may also telephone your telegrams from public and semi-public coin box telephones and deposit the charges for such messages in the coin box.

When calling either of these telegraph companies, follow the instructions shown under its listing in this directory. If the telegraph company which you are calling has no office in your local calling area or if the office is closed, and you desire further information, ask the Information Operator to assist you. The regular telephone charges apply on calls to telegraph offices.

Identification of Employes

Every employe of the Telephone Company authorized to inspect, repair or remove the Company's apparatus carries a metal badge showing the Company's name and his own number. Customers are earnestly requested to refuse access to their premises to anyone who cannot in this way identify himself.

Attachments to Telephones

The Company tariff provides that no apparatus or appliance not furnished by the Company shall be attached to or used in connection with its facilities. Telephone instruments are designed to produce the best results and are necessarily very sensitive and intricate. The various unauthorized devices offered for sale and which are guaranteed to improve transmission, eliminate noise, destroy germs and supplant the telephone directory, etc., are unnecessary. Many of them get the telephone lines out of order and the Company, to protect its service, is compelled to remove them. Where ordinary apparatus does not adequately meet a particular set of conditions special equipment will be furnished by the Company at reasonable rates.

Privacy of Telephone Service

"A person who wrongfully obtains, or attempts to obtain, any knowledge of a telegraphic or telephonic message by connivance with a clerk, operator, messenger or other employe of a telegraph or telephone company, or being such clerk, operator, messenger or other employe, wilfully divulges to anyone but the persons for whom it was intended, the contents or the nature thereof of a telegraphic or telephonic message or despatch intrusted to him for the transmission or delivery, or of which contents he may in any manner become possessed . . . is punishable by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not more than two years or both such fine and imprisonment."—Extract from Section 552 of the Penal Law, Chapter 40, of the Consolidated Laws.

Injuring Telephone Property

"A person who wilfully or maliciously displaces, removes, injures or destroys: a line of telegraph or telephone, wire or cable, pier or abutment, or the material or property belonging thereto, without lawful authority, or who shall unlawfully and wilfully cut, break, tap, or make connection with any telegraph or telephone line, wire, cable or instrument, or read or copy in any unauthorized manner any message, communication or report passing over it, in this state; or who shall wilfully prevent, obstruct or delay, by any means or contrivance whatsoever, the sending, transmission, conveyance or delivery, in this state of any authorized message, communication or report by or through any telegraph or telephone line, wire or cable, under the control of any telegraph, or telephone company doing business in this state; or who shall aid, agree with, employ or conspire with any person or persons to unlawfully do, or permit or cause to be done, any of the acts hereinbefore mentioned, or who shall occupy, use a line, or shall knowingly permit another to occupy, use a line, a room, table, establishment or apparatus to unlawfully do or cause to be done any of the acts hereinbefore mentioned . . . is punishable by imprisonment for not more than two years."—Extract from Section 1423 of the Penal Law.
