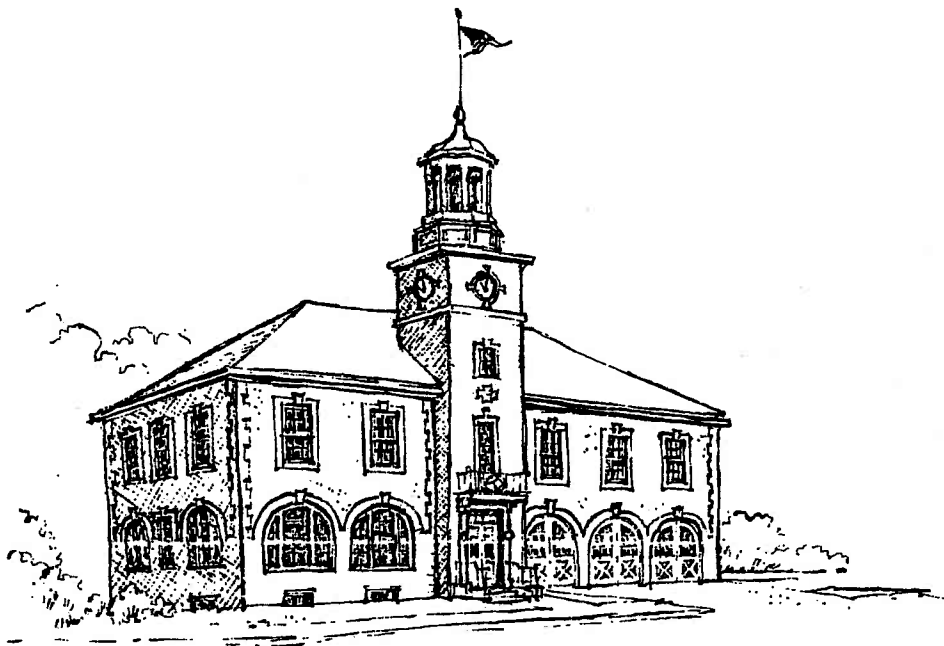

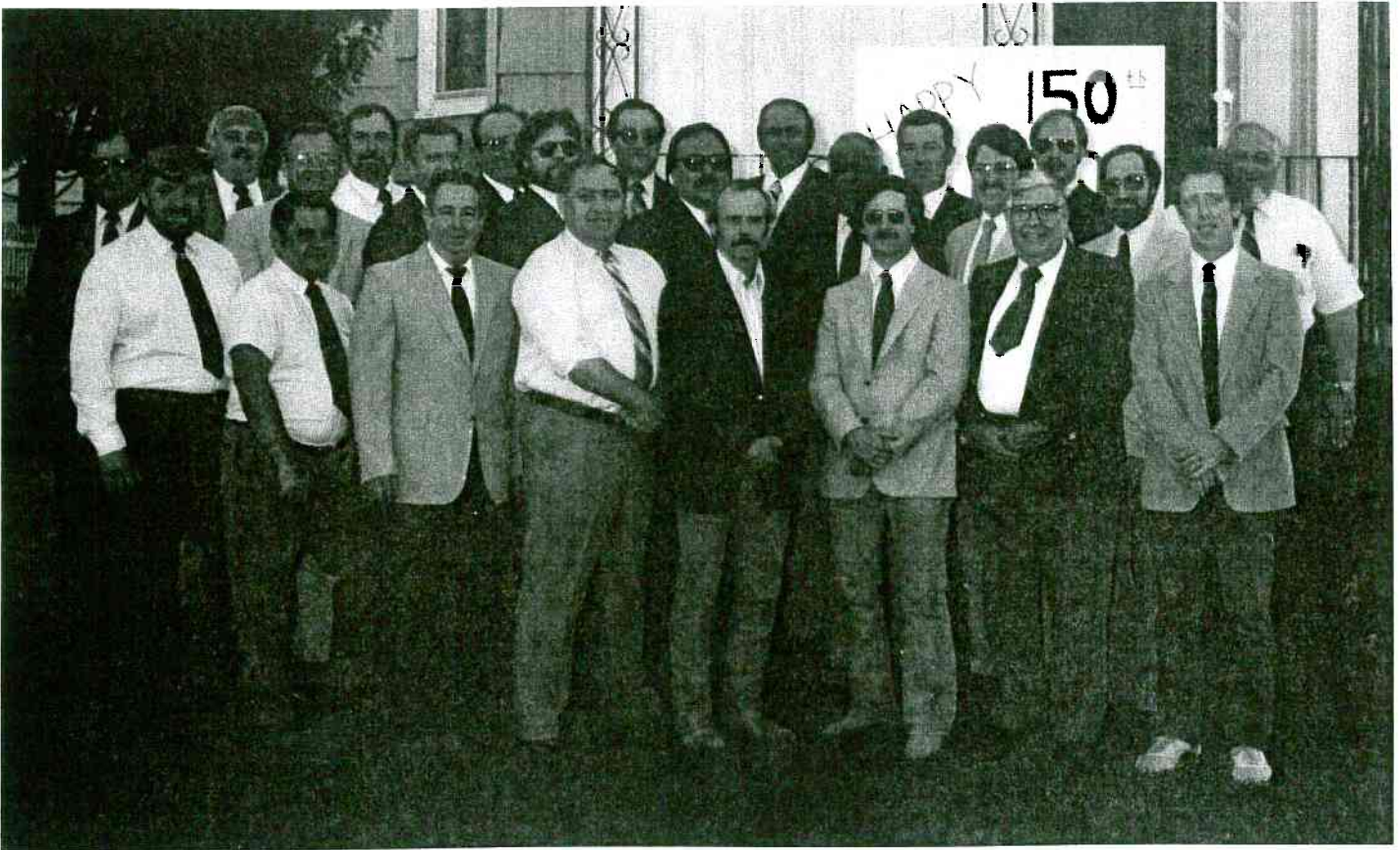

By the Trustees of the Village of Le Roy, an Ordinance for the prevention and extinguishment of Fires in said Village, passed August 9, 1834, and amended January 31, 1851.

SECTION 1.—It is ordained by the Trustees of the village of Le Roy, that it shall be the duty of every resident owner of any building or buildings in said village, and if such owner shall not be a resident of said village, then of each and every occupant or occupants of any tenement in said village in which a fire shall be kept, to provide a safe deposite for ashes, to be made of materials not subject to take fire, or if made of wooden materials the same shall not be placed or permitted to stand within the distance of two rods from any combustible substance; and whoever shall offend against the provisions of this section, shall forfeit and pay to the said Trustees the sum of Five dollars.

SEC. 2.—Every resident owner of any building in said village, and if such owner shall not be a resident of said village, then the occupant or occupants of any such building, shall at all times after the 15th day of October next, provide, and such occupant shall keep the following number of fire buckets; viz: for each and every building or part of building having one fire-place or stove, one bucket; for four fire-places or stoves two buckets; and for every building having over seven fire-places or stoves three buckets, with the owner's name painted on each bucket; and he she or they shall keep the same hanging in some conspicuous place in some part of said building, and every owner or occupant, as the case may be, who shall neglect or refuse to keep the number of fire-buckets and in the manner provided by this section, shall for every such offence, neglect or refusal, forfeit and pay to the said Trustees the sum of Two dollars for each bucket.

SEC. 3.—It shall be the duty of the fire wardens, within twenty days from the publication of this ordinance, to inspect all chimneys, fire-places, and depositories for ashes, stoves and stove-pipes within the village, and as often thereafter as they shall deem it necessary, and to see that they are properly and safely constructed and put up and kept: and for a majority of them from time to time to order such repairs, alterations or improvements in relation to any chimney, fire-place, stove, stove-pipe or depository, as they shall deem necessary for the safety of the building or the village; and it shall be the duty of every owner of any such chimney, fire-place, stove, stove-pipe, or depository, if he or she be a resident of such village, or the occupant of the tenement in which the same are situated, or to which they belong, if the owner thereof be not a resident, to obey and comply with any such order of said wardens, and to make any such repair, alteration or improvement as they may direct; and whoever shall neglect or refuse to comply with any such order, shall forfeit and pay to the Trustees of said village the sum of Five dollars.

SEC. 4.—It shall be the duty of the Fire Companies annually to elect from their number a chief engineer, and an assistant engineer, whose duty it shall be, whenever any fire shall break out in said village, to repair to such fire and to give all orders and directions to the fire companies, touching the extinguishing of such fires.—And it shall be the duty of said firemen to obey all orders and direction of such officers; and if any fireman shall disobey such order or direction, he shall for every such offence or disobedience, forfeit and pay to the said Trustees the sum of Two dollars.

SEC. 5.—It shall be the duty of the fire-wardens of said village whenever any fire shall break out in said village, with all convenient speed to repair to and attend to such fire, and to command and require the persons present (except firemen) to aid and assist in extinguishing the same, and to order and direct as they or any of them shall deem proper in relation to the preservation of property exposed to the dangers thereof, and see that lines are formed for the passing of water in buckets to be applied for the extinguishment of the fire, and to command and require all persons present (except as aforesaid) to do all things which may be necessary and proper for the extinguishing of such fire, and to use all proper measures to compel obedience to the order or direction which they or either of them may give in relation to the extinguishment of such fire or in the preservation of property; and if any such fire-warden shall be guilty of any neglect to

perform any such duty as aforesaid, he shall for every such neglect, forfeit and pay to the said Trustees the sum of Five dollars.

SEC. 6.—It shall and may be lawful for the President and any trustee or fire-warden, and it is hereby made their duty respectively, to order, remove and keep away from the vicinity of any such fire, all idle, disobedient or suspicious persons; and if any person shall refuse or neglect to obey such order or direction, such person shall forfeit and pay to the Trustees Five dollars.

SEC. 7.—No person other than the said Engineers, shall at the time of any fire give any order or direction to the said fire companies in relation to the extinguishment thereof;—and each and every person who shall give any such order or direction, without the authority of one of the engineers, shall for each and every such offence forfeit and pay to the Trustees the sum of Five dollars.

SEC. 8.—It shall be the duty of every member of any Fire or Hook and Ladder Company of said village, whenever an alarm of fire is given, unless prevented by sickness or some other inability, immediately to repair to the place where the Engine or Hooks and Ladders shall be deposited, and to aid in taking them to such fire, and then to obey the commands or directions of said Engineers touching the extinguishment of said fire, and to carry such directions into effect as far as practicable. Any member of any Fire or Hook and Ladder Company offending against any provision of this section, shall forfeit and pay to the Trustees of said village the sum of Five dollars.

SEC. 9.—No person shall fire any pistol, gun, rifle, rocket, mortar, cracker, squib, or other fire-arms or works within said village, or cause the same to be done, except by the consent of a majority of the Trustees. Every person offending against the provisions of this section, shall forfeit and pay to the said Trustees the sum of One dollar for each offence.

SEC. 10.—No person shall set fire to or burn, or cause to be fired or burnt, any chips, shavings, straw or other combustible materials in any street, lane or alley, or upon any lot within thirty feet of any building or combustible material within said village, for the sole purpose of consuming the same, or making a bonfire thereof and in no place in said village shall such fire be set after the setting of the sun. Every person offending against the provisions of this section shall forfeit to said Trustees the sum of Four dollars.

SEC. 11.—No person shall boil any oil, or make varnish in any place in said village within thirty feet of any building or collection of combustible substance, unless it shall be in some building twenty rods distant from any other building, or from any collection of combustible substance, and any person who shall set any fire in the open air within twenty rods of any building for the purpose of heating tire, or any purpose whatever shall wholly extinguish the same before leaving it. Whoever shall offend against any provision of this section shall forfeit and pay to the Trustees the sum of Five dollars.

SEC. 12.—It shall not be lawful for any person or persons to take or carry, or cause to be taken and carried into, or to suffer or permit to remain in any barn, barnyard or stable in said village, and lighted lamp, candle, torch or gas, unless the same be enclosed and secured in a lantern; nor shall any person take or carry any lighted cigar or pipe of tobacco into any barn or barnyard or stable in said village. Every person offending against any provision of this section shall forfeit and pay to the said Trustees Five dollars.

SEC. 13.—The bell ringer or bell ringers of every public bell in said village, shall immediately on the cry or alarm of fire, severally ring or cause to be rung their respective bells for the space of at least twenty minutes, unless the fire shall be sooner extinguished. Any bell ringer offending against the provisions of this section shall forfeit and pay to the said Trustees the sum of Three dollars.
