INTRODUCTION

New York State is rich in history and equally rich in institutions which maintain the documentary evidence of that history. At the present time there are more than five hundred historical agencies, more than twenty-two hundred public libraries, and more than one hundred and seventy-five colleges and universities operating in the Empire State. All of these organizations, to varying degrees, hold manuscripts and archival materials which chronicle the historical events of the locality, the region, the State, and the Nation. Unfortunately, most of these primary research materials have never been reported to the general public in any systematic way. The great variety of repositories, and the lack of a comprehensive finding aid, has made it extremely difficult for researchers to locate the primary source materials needed for the study of New York State's history. In an attempt to rectify this situation, the New York Historical Resources Center began a state-wide survey of manuscripts and archives collections in repositories in 1978. The survey has been established as a priority of the New York State Historical Records Advisory Board appointed by the Governor of the State. This Guide is a part of that effort.

The goal of the survey is to locate, identify, describe, and report all of the manuscripts and archives materials in New York State repositories. There is no determination made as to the historical or research value of particular collections. Therefore, all documentary materials found in repositories are reported in the Guides.

Since this is a state-wide, collection-level survey the descriptions in the County Guides must, of necessity, be brief. The depth of description depends, to a great extent, on the size of the collection, the level of arrangement, and the presence or lack of adequate finding aids. Limitations of time and resources, as well as those imposed by the computer, create a situation in which some collection descriptions are very brief and general while others are quite detailed. The intention is to provide an introduction to the collections, not a definitive description.

Using the SPINDEX III computer system, the New York Historical Resources Center plans to create a Guide for each of New York State's sixty-two counties. The Guides contain a descriptive register of collections and an index. The registers are arranged alphabetically by town or city. Within each town or city the repositories are arranged alphabetically, and the collections are arranged alphabetically, by collection title, within the repositories. Each collection has its own unique control number. The first two letters indicate the county, the next three numbers identify the town or city, the following three digits refer to the repository, and the last four numbers indicate the collection. Thus, GE48K-480-0011 refers to the Ingham University Collection (0011) which is located at the LeRoy Historical Society (480) in LeRoy (48K), Genesee County (GE). The control number appears before the narrative description of the

collection in the register. The index is arranged in one alphabet including personal names, organizational titles, place names, and subjects. Each index term refers to a register entry by collection title and control number. A researcher interested in education in LeRoy, New York will find information on that subject in the Ingham University Collection, GE48K-480-0011.

The repositories in Genesee County were surveyed by Robert T. Englert. The information was edited and indexed by Elaine D. Engst, Alan H. Haeberle, Marcia J. Hopson, and Amy D. Humber. All information is submitted to the National Historical Publications and Records Commission for inclusion in their national data base of manuscripts and archives collections. Information on all counties is available at the New York Historical Resources Center. Individual county Guides may be purchased from Cornell University Libraries. Updated Guides will be produced as new data becomes available.

This Guide was made possible by support from the National Historical Publications and Records Commission, Cornell University, and the New York State Council on the Arts. The cooperation of individuals in the local repositories and the Western New York Library Resources Council was critical to the successful completion of this Guide. Members of the Department of Manuscripts and University Archives at Cornell University provided essential resources, advice, and encouragement.
