Together with the appurtenances, and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever, of the said party of the first part, either in law or equity, of, in or to the above bargained premises: To have and to hold, the said premises above described, to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns to the sole and only proper use of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Elijah Herrick and Nancy his wife party of the first part, for their heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant, grant, bargain and agree, to and with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that at the time of the sealing and delivery of these presents, themselves well seized of the premises above conveyed, as of a good, sure, perfect, absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in the law in fee simple. And that the above bargained premises in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons, lawfully claiming or to claim, the whole or any part thereof, they will forever Warrant and Defend.
