Page 1:3 - THE DEATH OF MRS. MAFFITT - Mrs. Frances, wife of Rev. J.N. MAFFITT died in Brooklyn on Friday evening, the 29 ult, age 18 years & 7 days

Page 2:1 - FOUND DEAD IN HIS BED - Robert THOMPSON who boarded at Wm. GRIFFINS in the 4th Ward of this Village, was found dead in his bed on Saturday morning about 6 o'clock. The Jury was called and it appeared that he worked the day before, & went to bed about eleven the night previous, in usual health. Dr. VANALYSTINE who was in attendance, gave it as his opinion that he died in a fit of apoplexy; and the Jury gave a verdict accordingly.
