Page 2:2 - DEATH OF THOS. A. FARNAM - The Tribune notices the death of this gentleman in California - San Francisco, on 13th of September. He was formerly principal of an Academy in Jefferson County NY, afterwards a lawyer in Illinois whence he made the overland journey to Oregon in 1840. He remained there but a short time, returning by way of the Sandwich Islands and California, His account of the journey is one of the best ever written. Here turned to and settled in California in 1844-5 and resided there thence to his death. He leaves a widow (late matron of the Sing Sing Prison) and two promising sons (The gentleman named above was well-known in this vicinity. He was formerly Principal of the Academy at Waterford, Saratoga County, NY)
