Page 2:3 - FATAL ACCIDENT - On Saturday afternoon last Mr. Patrick TIMMENS was killed at the crossing of the western railroad in Broadway near Colonie Street in Albany. Mr. T. was in a two horse wagon and the horses taking fright, <sup>were</sup> brought up along side the locomotive and train going west, when he either jumped or fell out between the cars and team. The step of a car struck him in the breast staving it in and horribly mangling him. An inquest was held on his body and a verdict returned according to the circumstances.

Mr. T. was a resident of this Village and a member of Fire Company No. 3. His funeral was attended, on Monday, from the residence of his brother, Mr. Bernard TIMMENS by the several fire companies, together with a lengthy retinue of friends and acquaintances in carriages. It was one of the longest funeral processions we have ever witnessed in this vicinity.
