Page 3:1 - MARRIED - In this Village March 16th by Rev. J.C. BURROUGHS, Mr. John LAVOIS of Montreal C.E. to Miss Maria LIECKTE of West Troy.

APRIL 4, 1849

Page 2:5 - Judge FARRAR, the oldest living graduate of Harvard College, died in Hollis, NH in February. He graduated in 1767 and was 101 years & 7 months old.

APRIL 11, 1849

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - In Troy on the 5th inst., by Rev. N.S.S. BEAMAN, Mr. George HART of West Troy to Miss Elizabeth Jane ENSIGN of the former City.

- DIED - In this Village March 21st, Eliza REYNOLDS, wife of John REYNOLDS, age 36. (POEM)

APRIL 18, 1849

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - In Albany on the 11th inst by Rev. W.S. CLAPP, John W. WILBUR Esq. of West Troy to Miss Ellen CLUTE of Saratoga.

- DIED - At Brasos, Santiago on the 18th ult of cholera after an illness of six hours, Richard SCHUYLER, brother of T.H. SCHUYLER of this Village, in the 28th year of his age.

- In this Village on the 12th inst Mrs. Cecilia De MOORSSE, wife of Mr. Louis De WILDE, in the 69th year of her age. (The funeral procession left the residence of Mr. De WILDE on Saturday for St. Patrick's Church in accordance with ancient custom on foot, principal mourners & pall bearers included, - the friends and those nearest connected with the deceased conceiving it an act of humility, and the most appropriate manner of following the dead to "that bourne from whence no traveler ye'r returns".

APRIL 25, 1849

Page 2:1 - FOUND DROWNED - Early in the morning of the 19th inst., Mr. HALSEY, one of the ferrymen at the Upper Ferry, in this Village, found a man lying on his face and floating near the landing (person not named or identified and article goes on about the accident)

Page 3:1 - MARRIED - In this Village by Rev. T.F. WYCOFF. on Sabbath evening April 15th, Mr. Jasper WILSON of Lee County, Iowa to Miss Martha PILKINGTON of West Troy.

- DIED - In this Village on the 14th inst of consumption, Mr. Robert GIFFORD, age 41.
