Page 2:5 - MARRIED - On the 29th ultimo by the Rev. Mr. PEARSON, Mr. Lemuel CULVER & Miss Mary Ann CHRYSTIE of this Village.

DIED - In this Village on Tuesday 25th September, Henry L., son of John H. & Mary E. HODGEMAN, age 10 months & 14 days.

- In Lansingburgh on Sunday 23d September at 4 o'clock P.M. of consumption, Capt. Isaac STORER, in the 65th year of his age - At 6-1/2 o'clock on the same day and of the same disease, Clarissa Ann STORER, wife of Capt. Isaac STORER in the 53d year of her age. TOGETHER THEY HAD LIVED AND IN DEATH WERE NOT DIVIDED.

Page 2:1 - SUDDEN DEATH - On the 6th inst., John FLOOD who had been hostler several years for Mr. Robert MORRISON of this Village, left the dinner table in the midst of his meal and without complaint went out of the house, and, as appears, while entering at another door, fell nearly his length into the hall, where he was found a few minutes afterwards, and raised up; he breathed only once or twice and rested from the cares and troubles of his life. He had been subject to fits, and the jury said in substance that he died in a fit induced by some cause unknown to them. He was honest, faithful, kind and obliging to all and without an enemy; and though he had one failing, his merits were duly appreciated by Mr. MORRISON and family who saw him decently interred.

Page 2:4 - The late Rev. Henry COLMAN, who died at Islington, England, was buried with much pomp by his English friends. The place of interment was the gift of Lady BYRON, who has also undertaken to erect a monument to the deceased.

- The death of the Hon. Silas H. JENISON, late Gov. of Vermont, at his residence at Shoreham. on Sunday morning last is announced in the Middlebury Galaxy.

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - By the Rev. T.F. WYCKOFF on the 6th inst. Mr. Levi COLE to Miss Ann HURST, all of West Troy.

- The Rev. Dr. WYCKOFF was married on the 9th inst to Miss Cornelia REED, daughter of the late Roswell REED of Coxsackie, Greene Co., NY. The Rev. P.D. VAN CLEEF, of Coxsackie Landing, her present pastor, administered the ordinance, and the Rev. I. SEARLE, her former pastor asked the Benediction.
