

JUNE 12, 1839

On Page 2 there is two long columns on the death of Dr. NELSON L. HUNGERFORD. This gives no family information but does state he was buried from the Dutch Reform Church in West Troy.

AUGUST 7, 1839

On Page 2 there is statement from the Ohio Republican Newspaper Elyria, Ohio that Dr. LATHAM of Columbia Township was killed by lightning.

AUGUST 14, 1839

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - On the 1st Inst by Rev. J. POOR OF Saratoga Springs Mr. William W. RAYMOND of Ballston to Miss Almira DAVID of West Troy

AUGUST 28, 1839

Page 2:5 - DIED - At his residence in Watervliet on the 23rd Inst Mr. Benjamin KNOWER in the 64th year of his age.

- At Milan, Ohio on the 4th of July Mr. Timothy CONKLIN at the advanced age of 96 years. Mr. CONKLIN served as a lieutenant in the Army of the Revolution under Washington. He died while attending the celebration of the fourth being taken with an apoplectic fit at the first discharge of cannon as the national banner rose to the top of the liberty pole on the public square at Milan.

SEPTEMBER 18, 1839

Page 2:4 - MARRIED - In this Village on the 1st Inst by Rev. George PHIPPEN Elisha M. DOUGLAS of Waterford, Conn. and Lucy MARTIN of West Troy.

DIED - An eminent lawyer DAVID GRAHAM sr of New York died on Thursday morning after an illness of three days.

DIED - The Hon. Jas. R. BLACK, Judge of Superior Court in the State of Delaware died at his residence in Newcastle on Tuesday Evening last

SEPTEMBER 25, 1839

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - In this Village on the 18th Inst by Rev. Mr. LEONARD of Albany Mr. Jeremiah L. BECKER of Troy to Miss Margaret A. daughter of Mr. Daniel MacBETH of this place.

- In this town on the 18th Inst by the same, Mr. William P. BRAYTON of Bethlehem to Miss Esther BENNETT of Watervliet.
