Page 2:1- SUDDEN & AWFUL DEATH - On Wednesday a laboring man, by the name of DEWIT, employed for about three weeks past at Mr. A. RICHARDS Planing Mill, in this Village, was almost instantly deprived of life, by being revolved around a drum, the belt of which he had just attached. It was making some 300 or 400 revolutions a minute, and his body was literally mangled and divided into several parts - It was an awful sight to look upon. He leaves no family. From the frequency of such accidents, we are inclined to think that more care is necessary in performance of such duties.

- MURDER TRIAL - The trial of Charles QUINN on the charge of the murder of Michael GLEASON commenced in Troy on Wednesday, Judge WATSON residing. It will probably be ended this week.
