Page 2:2 - A long obituary on the death of Henry CLAY who was born April 12, 1777. He died June 29, 1852, aged 75 years 2 months 17 days.

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - In this Village on July 1st 1852 by the Rev. J.C. BURROUGHS, Mr. Edwin S. KNICKERBOCKER to Miss Eliza Ann BREWSTER, both of Albany.
