Page 2:1 - DEATHS FROM COLORA - The Madison Observer records the following, "Among its victims last week were Mr. Henry C. GARDINER formerly a respectable resident of this town, his son-in-law Mr. Henry HULL and his daughter the wife of Mr. HULL. Mr. HULL and his wife were on their way from Buffalo and, when near Albion Mrs. HULL was taken ill and died there. Mr. HULL started with her remains for Syracuse, and on his way there was himself taken sick, and died soon after reaching that place. Both were buried in one grave. Mr. GARDINER who resided in Canastota, being informed of their sickness went to see them, was with them during their sickness and death, and soon after his return to Canastota was taken ill and died on Thursday last after about two days sickness. The surviving members of this stricken family are worthy of the sympathy of this community which they were once respected residents."

- A little boy about five years of age son of Hiram WOOD of Waterford while playing with a glass stopple of a vinegar cruet swallowed it and before assistance could be procured, he choked to death.
