Page 2:2 - Drowned between Lock No's 11 & 12 on the 5th inst. Simon TRABER, aged about 10 years, son of Mr. Peter TRABER of this Village. The body was recovered on Sunday last. (Cohoes Cataract 16th)

OCTOBER 27, 1852

Page 2:1 - THE WEST TROY MURDER CASE - Matthew O'BRIEN, the person charged with the murder of Bulley O'NEIL in a fracas near the Upper Side -Cut about a fortnight since has been committed for manslaughter in the first degree, by Justice M. WINNE beore whom the case was examined on Monday.

Page 2:2 - A long obit on the death of Daniel WEBSTER - died at Marshfield, on Sunday morning, at about 20 minutes before 3 o'clock.

Page 2:5 - DIED - In this Village on the 18th inst., Mr. Peter RODGERS, age 67 years.

Page 2:5 - Francis BECROFT, a Revolutionary Soldier died at Schoharie on the 2d inst., age 102 years. When his father was 105 and his mother was 102 years of age, they mounted the same horse and together rode from Bort's Mill, in the Town of Schoharie, two miles distance, without appearing to suffer materially from the fatigue. The family has always been noted for longevity.
