Page 2:3 - MARRIED - On the 16th inst. by the Rev. N.G. SPAULDING, Mr. Peter GROOM of Fort Byron to Mrs. Betsey COOPER of this Village.

- DIED - On the morning of the 18th inst. Martha Harriet, infant daughter of Theodore & Eliza GLEASON, aged 7 months & 16 days.

MAY 4, 1853

Page 2:3 - MARRIED - In Trinity Church in this Village April 27th by the Rev. Philander K. CADY, Mr. Joseph K. JENNINGS of Albany to Miss Emma LEWIS of West Troy.

MAY 11, 1853

Page 2:1 - A young man named Charles C. WELLINGTON, aged about 25 years, formerly a resident of Hamilton, Madison Co., NY, committed suicide at Catham (Chatham) Four Corners on Saturday last by taking prusic acid. He left the city on the same day and put up at H. ALLEN'S Hotel. He is supposed to have been insane. (from the Knickerbocker Thursday).

MAY 18, 1853

Page 2:1 - SUICIDE - Mrs. Delany SHERWOOD while laboring under mental derangement, hung herself with a rope on the 11th inst. to a post of the bed in her room adjoining the one in which she slept the night previous. She was discovered about 7 A.M. and was last seen alive at 6-1/2 A.M. Means were used to resuscitate her but they proved unavailing. An inquest was held and the jury's verdict was in accordance with the facts as stated above.

Page 2:1 - An inquest was held on the 12th inst. on the body of John SHERWOOD who was drowned by falling from the steamboat J.J. AUSTIN, April 30th while throwing a line to a Canal Boat, The jury's verdict was that he was accidentally drowned by falling into the Hudson River from the deck of the Steamer AUSTIN.

- POISONED BY SHAD - A strange death is mentioned as having occurred in New York from eating Shad. The woman's name was Elizabeth JONES, and from the evidence given on the inquest which was held, it appeared that the unfortunate woman having eaten very heartily of the fish, was seized with convulsion and died on Monday evening. The medical testimony corroborated the evidence, and the jury rendered a suitable verdict.
