Page 2:1 - The funeral of young VAN SCHAICK who lost his life in the Empire disaster was attended from the residence of his father yesterday afternoon. He was a member of the 5th Street Sabbath Baptist School, the teachers and pupils of which were mostly present at his funeral (BUDGET, Monday)

Page 2:4 - MARRIED - On the 16th inst at the Albany Rural Cemetery by the Rev. Mr. GREEN, Mr. Samuel H. WEATHERWAX to Miss Charlotte A. DUBOIS, both of Sand Lake.

DIED - In this Village on the 14th inst. Eugenia M. only daughter of William & Elizabeth CEMENCE age 22 months & 18 days.

Page 2:1 - DEATH BY POISON - We understand that the Coroner held an inquest on the body of Mary Ann SMITH who lived the lower part of this Village and who died on Sunday afternoon 24th inst. The jury returned a verdict that the deceased came to her death by poison administered by a man named Henry HAWES and the mother of the deceased. The examination will take place today.

Page 2:3 - MARRIED - At Woodstock, VT on July 16 at the residence of Reuben DANIELS Esq. by the Rev. Mr. DOUGLASS, Samuel H. DAYTON Esq. of Watervliet to Miss Helen DAVISON of Clenawee County, Michigan.

DIED - In this Village on 21st inst. Thaddeus S., infant son of John & Martha D. PERRIGO, age 6 months & 26 days.

AUGUST 3, 1853

Page 2:1- DREADFUL ACCIDENT - A little hero - A boy 14 years of age employed in Baxter's Mill in this Village, lost his arm on Wednesday morning last in the most shocking manner. It seems they took off the cover of the cotton picker and attempted to take out some loose cotton, when his hand was caught by the teeth of the cylinder and his arms drawn in until his body was brought up against the machine. His cries were called by Messrs. VAN NESS & HALL at Hollister's Store who ran to the spot, and rushing in the room, found the little fellow held fast by the picker, which was still in motion and revolving over 1000 times per minute.....(article goes on about all the gory details of accident)...As his parents lived in Albany it was thought best to remove him there where his arm was amputated by Dr. MARCH.
