She was carried to Dr. Blake's office where the limb was amputated by Dr. THORN of Troy who was immediately sent for. Had not the wheel been stopped by the timber her whole body would have been crushed. She is the daughter of James RYAN, teamster for D. SIMMONS & Co. The poor sufferer and her family have our most heartfelt sympathy.

Page 2:2 - DEATH OF THE SLEEPING MAN - We learn from the Rochester Democrat that Cornelius VROOMAN died at his brother's residence in Clarkson on Monday the 17th inst. While on exhibition in New York he was taken sick, which seem to induce a wakeful state for a short period and a ^{then} stupid condition with intervals of wakefulness until he was brought home on the 14th. He talked but little inquiring after his mother, who had been dead two years, his father & brothers, whom he seemed partially to recognize. He complained of great internal heat, and soreness of his throat & stomach. On the morning of the day of his death he called for food, and ate a hearty meal, and from that time seem to be in pain until about 2 o'clock P.M., when he died without a struggle. His age was some 34 years.
