Page 2:2 - POISONED - A lad about four years old named Gilbert OLIVER residing with his Uncle, a Mr. DENNISTON on the Albany & Shaker Plank Road was poisoned on the 21st inst. under the following circumstances: A quantity of corrosive sublimate had been prepared in a tumbler for the killing of bugs by a lady inmate of the house which she left on the table, and during a momentary absence, the child grasped the tumbler and drank it down. Medical assistance was called in, but too late to save the child, who died five hours afterwards. This should serve as a fearfult warning to all persons never to leave preparations of this character, not even for an instant, in places where they are liable to be seized by children.
