Page 3:1 - MARRIED - On the 18th ult by the Rev. Mr. William ARTHUR, Mr. Abraham BUYS of Rotterdam, NY to Miss Bridget BARRON of the same place.

- On the 7th inst by the same, Mr. Frielling F. THOMPSON of Cohoes to Miss Sarah A. BRIGGS of Athens, Greene Co.

DIED - In this Village on the 4th inst., at the residence of his son-in-law Gen. Dunham PECK, Col. H. SAGE in the 66th year of his age.

- At the Troy Marshall Infirmary on Sunday morning June 10th of consumption, Jeremiah MAHAR, Printer, aged 19 years.

JUNE 20, 1855

Page 2:4 - DROWNED - A lad of about five years of age Clarence RUNKLE, while at play with several other boys, on Monday afternoon last, fell into the race-way leading from Bailey & Egbert's Mill, Seneca St., Cohoes, was drowned. His body was not recovered until yesterday morning, when it was found in the Mohawk River, about 500 feet from the place where he fell. Coroner WITBECK held an inquest, and a verdict was returned in accordance with the above facts.

JUNE 27, 1855

Page 2:5- DEATH BY DROWNING - The body of a man named Patrick BARREY was found in the Canal near the upper side-cut on Monday. He was last seen alive near midnight on Saturday going towards his home, and it is supposed that he walked into the Canal. Coroner WITBECK impaneled a jury and held an inquest upon the body, the jury returning a verdict of accidental drowning.

Page 3:1 -MARRIED - In Waterford on the 13th inst. by Rev. J. LAGRANGE, Mr. John V. VAN WOERT of this Village to Miss Joanna E. THORNE of the former place.

DIED - In this Village on the 23d inst. Merrit POTTER, age 44 years.

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - On the 21st ult by the Rev. Mr. GREGORY, Mr. Samuel CRAWFORD of this Village to Miss Jane Ann JOHNSON of Watervliet.

Page 3:2 - DROWNED WHILE ATTEMPTING TO SAVE THE LIVES OF OTHERS - A young man named Charles PERKINS, residing in Troy,
