Page 2:5 - Albany - Mary AGER, wife of John AGER, has been arrested, and charged with poisoning her husband, who died and was buried very suddenly on Thursday last. John AGER jr, step-son of the prisioner, was the complainant.

SEPTEMBER 3, 1856

Page 2:2 - Enoch DAVIS, Associate Editor of the Troy Times, died at the residence of his father in Shaftsbury, VT on Sunday last. The Times of Monday afternoon appeared in mourning in consequence.

BOY KILLED BY A HORSE - On last Thursday afternoon, a boy about 15 years of age, named John DeGRAFF, who resided in Amsterdam, but was employed as a driver, while driving a team attached to a boat on the Erie Canal about two miles above this Village, struck one of the horses with a strap, when the horse gave him a violent kick in the region of the heart, killing him almost instantly.
