OCTOBER 21, 1840

Page 2:5 - DIED - In this Village on Saturday morning last 17th Inst Mrs. Louisa, wife of Mr. Robert AYER, Merchant, age 37

Same Day - after a lingering illness caused by the accidental discharge of a cannon on the 4th of July last, Mr. John VARLEY.

OCTOBER 28, 1840

Page 2:4 - In our Chronicle of the 4th of Sept we announced the marriage after four days courtship of James HOBBS Esq to Harriet W. CHAMBERS, the bridegroom in his 77th year; the bride in her 16th. On the 4th of September Mr. HOBBS stepping with his bride into his carriage fell down dead (Shrewsbury Chronicle)
