It is supposed he had been experimenting upon the process of hanging induced perhaps by the recent execution of Leddings, and just when no one happened to be in the hall placed himself in a situation beyond his own power of relief and when discovered he was quite dead. This is the most rational supposition, as no cause can be assigned for self-destruction and he had enjoyed the holidays with the buoyancy of spirits natural to his age (from the Albany Argus)
