Page 2:4 - MARRIED - In this Village October 8th by Rev. C.W. HOMAR, Mr. Silas BETTS & Miss Louise H., eldest daughter of Capt. Jacob YOUNG.

OCTOBER 21, 1857

Page 2:2 - CORONER'S INQUEST - Coroner WITBECK held an inquest on Thursday last, at Cohoes, upon the body of a lad about eight years of age, named John NASH jr who fell dead while playing with other boys in a building on the corner of White & Remsen Street in that Village. Verdict - death from disease of the heart.

He was also called to hold an inquest yesterday morning upon the body of Terrance MEHAN, age 25, who fell in Lock 6, Erie Canal, while in the discharge of his duty as lock tender. Verdict - accidental drowning.

Page 3:1 - MARRIED - In Charlestown, Mass. Sept 22d, Mr. George O. TYLER of Lowell and Miss Lizzie H. PATTEN of Charlestown, formerly of West Troy.

DIED - In this Village on Sunday morning October 11th, Gurdon YEARSLEY, aged 2 years & 8 months; also Sunday afternoon October 18th, Warren YEARSLEY, aged 5 years & 1 month, sons of Wm. & Sarah YEARSLEY.

Page 2:1 - THE CHICAGO FIRE - Chicago papers of the 23d and 24th contain full accounts of the burial of the bodies of the victims of the late conflagration in that City, and of the inquest which is still proceeding..... the corpse of D.C. EMERSON, late of Lawrence, Mass. was buried with Masonic honors, deceased having been a member of the order, the bodies of Ezra S. BARNUM and E.R. CLARK of Utica, Abram BOGART of New York and A.H.P. CORNING of Troy were sent home for interment.....

Page 2:3 - SUICIDE - Horace B. SALISBURY of Geddes, near Syracuse, arrived in Troy a few days since, in quest of his wife. He found her in a house of prostitution, which so worked on his mind that he took arsenic, enough to end his troubles.

Page 3:1 - MARRIED - On the 20th inst. at St. John's Church, Hartford, by Rev. Philander K. CADY, assisted by Rev. E. A. WASHBURN, D. Knight CADY jr of Cincinnati and Miss Mary Ellen FARWELL of Hartford.

DIED - In this Village on Tuesday October 27th 1857, Belindia wife of Hiram ROBERTS. The funeral will take place from the residence of the family (Temperance Hill) on Thursday the 29th at 2 o'clock P.M. Friends and acquaintances are invited to attend.
