Page 2:2 - BOY DROWNED - Coroner WITBECK of this Village held an inquest on Sunday, at Cohoes, on the body of Augustus KING, age 13 years, who was accidentally caught in a tow line attached to a canal boat, and thus precipitated into Lock 13, Erie Canal, and before assistance could be rendered, was drowned.

Page 2:6 - DIED - In this Village on Sunday morning December 6th, Eliza G., daughter of Justin & Lucenia BOWMAN, age 3 years, 10 months.

DECEMBER 16, 1857

Page 2:6 - MARRIED - In this Village on the 9th inst by Rev. Angelo CANOLL, Mr. Matthew W. CHAMBERS, West Troy & Miss Adaline KELLOGG, formerly of Williamstown, Mass.

DIED - In this Village on Thursday December 10, 1857 Samuel CRAWFORD jr, age 34 years 11 months 9 days.

DECEMBER 23, 1857

Page 2:6 - MARRIED - In this Village on Wednesday 16th inst., by Rev. E. STOVER, Mr. Edgar A. LEARNED and Miss Althea L. HOLBLOOK, both of West Troy.

DIED - In Watervliet on Monday 21st inst. Mary Emily wife of Peter B. LEVINGS. Friends of the family are invited to attend her funeral at the residence of her husband in Watervliet at 1 o'clock P.M. today.

Page 2:5 - We notice the death of Mr. Alexander H. WELLS in Sing Sing on Monday. Mr. W. was Surrogate of Westchester Co. in 1840, State Prison Inspector in 1849 and at different times Warden of the Sing Sing Prison. His age was about 50. He has been the Editor of several papers in different parts of the State. Mr. WELLS formerly resided in Troy.
