Page 2:2 - At Clinton Prison on the 23d inst. Henry HARTLY who was serving out a term of imprisonment for grand larceny in stealing a quantity of canvas from a boat at this place last summer, - fell from the roof of a building on which he was at work, and was so seriously injured he died in 24 hours.

Page 2:6 - MARRIED - On Wednesday 24th inst at the residence of the bride's father in Watervliet by the Rev. Dr. BALDWIN, Mr. Chas. E. WISWALL and Miss Mary A. DAYTON.

Page 2:3 - DEATH OF HON. SAMUEL DICKSON - We regret being obliged to announce the death of Hon. Samuel DICKSON which occurred at his residence in New Scotland on Monday evening. Mr. D. faithfully represented this district in the last Congress. His death was a result of spinal injuries received while at Washington.
