Page 3:1 - MARRIED - On the 5th inst by Rev. B. HAWLEY, Thomas C. DENNISTON to Agnes GRANT, both of West Troy.

Page 2:3 - MURDER IN ALBANY - Thomas N. FRANCIS, keeper of a saloon on Clinton Ave., Albany, last Thursday night murdered a woman named HILTON, with whom he had been living as his wife. He beat her brains out with a hammer, then locked the house up and escaped, but was captured again Friday morning.

Page 2:6 - DIED - In Watervliet on Sunday June 20th, Lewis MORRIS, aged 65 years.

Page 2:2 - DEATH FROM SUN STROKE - A man named Matthew BRADY employed on Ida Hill Troy, died from the effects of sun stroke on Friday afternoon last.

Andrew MADIGAN a man about 40 years of age, employed at the steam Saw & Planing Mill of Nathan DAUCHY 2d, in this Village, died from the effects "coup de soleil" or sun stroke on Saturday afternoon last. He was taken home about noon insensible and survived but four hours. Coroner WITBECK held an inquest.

Page 2:5 - MELANCHOLY CASUALTY - The oldest son of Judge SELDON, of the Court of Appeals, age 12 years was drowned on Friday in Irondequoit Bay, near Rochester where the Judge resides. He had gone to the bay in company with his father, for the purpose of learning how to swim. It was while the father was teaching his boy that the accident occurred.

Page 2:6 - MARRIED - In this Village on Thurs. 24th inst., by Rev. Dr. GREGORY, Mr. Melvin L. CLUTE to Miss Mary E. BLUNT, both of this place.

- DIED - In this Village on Friday the 25th inst. Nancy MENEELY, wife of Isaac HITCHCOCK in the 60th year of her age.

- On the 26th inst., from injuries received from falling into a celler, Sarah D., daughter of John & Orpha OOTHOUT, age 7 years.
