Page 2:3 - DEATH OF JOHN N. WILDER - John N. WILDER died at the Delavan House, Albany on Thursday afternoon last. He was struck down by an apoplectic fit, and expired instantly. Mr. W. was about 44 years of age. He was a man of brilliant talents and generous impulses. His funeral took place from the North Pearl St. Baptist Church, in that City, on Saturday afternoon. During thesame, most of the principal business houses in the City were closed, and the flags on the various public buildings displayed at half mast.

Page 3:1 - NOTICE - All persons are hereby forbid harboring or trusting my wife BETSEY on my account, as I shall pay no debt of her contracting after this date. s/Peter CONNOR - West Troy - May 7 1858

Page 2:1 - FATAL RAILROAD ACCIDENT - A serious accident occurred to the night train on the Housatonic near New Milford on Saturday night by its running over a cow on a track. The middle car was thrown down an enbankment of 30 feet, killing LEVI A. MILLS Esq. of Fairfield - formerly of the firm of MILLS Brothers Company of New York and seriously injuring Mrs. BASSET Of Bridgeport and slightly injuring some five or six others.

- MURDER AT POESTENKILL - On Wed. night last, William DIAMOND, a man of about 60 years of age, was stabbed in the arm and neck with a pocket knife by his brother, Henry DIAMOND, aged about 70 while in a quarrel. William lived but about six hours after the stabbing. The murderer was arrested and is now in the Troy jail.

Page 2:5 - DEAD - Rev. Dr. SMALLEY, Pastor of the Sixth St. Presbyterian Church in Troy died at his residence in that City on Friday morning last.
