Page 2:6 - DIED - In Troy on the 17th inst. Rev. J.N. FAIRCHILD, Pastor of the Baptist Church, of this Village, age 24 years, 7 months & 7 days.

- At Minneapolis, Minn. Jan 24th, Eliza C. wife of Edwin TALLCOTT, age 40 years 5 months & 8 days.

MARCH 3, 1859

Page 2:3 - FRANCIS who killed Rachel HILTON, his mistress in Albany, and was convicted of manslaughter in the 1st degree, Thursday received from Judge POTTER a sentence to 10 years & 3 months imprisonment at Clinton. He is 60 years old and will hardly live to finish his term.

MARCH 9, 1859

Page 2:3 - HORRIBLE MURDER AT COHOES - One Michael O'BRIEN murdered his wife at Cohoes, on Tuesday night of last week. On Wednesday morning, when the fact first became known through the Village, the scene of the tragedy was visited by large numbers, and one of the most sickening sights ever beheld was there presented. The deceased was lying on a bed, her face completely blackened and disfigured by bruises, her eyes swollen and completely closed, her shoulders, breasts & arms, in fact her whole body, bore the prints of bruises evidently inflicted by the murderer's heels, as the marks of the nails in the shoes were plainly visible but few could calmly look upon the frightful spectacle. The poor victim had been literally stamped to death. A few hours after, O'BRIEN was arrested at the residence of his brother in South Troy wither he had fled. Coroner WITBECK proceeded to hold an inquest upon the body of the deceased etc.....
..... O'BRIEN was of course committed to jail to await the action of the next Grand Jury.

Page 3:1 - DIED - In Union Village, Washington Co. on Sunday the 27th ult, Warren BLAKELY, formerly of this Village, age 29 years.

Page 2:3 - SHOCKING ACCIDENT - A shocking accident occurred at half past three Monday afternoon, at PRUYN & LANSING's Boiler Works, Albany, whereby Timothy MURPHY a helper at the forge &c lost his life. He was about to take down boiler iron leaning against a wall, when, on moving a sheet, it was too heavy for him to support, other sheets followed it, and the combined weight of six, ^{each} averaging 150 pounds - came upon him, crushing him down and on to a block. His head was there caught and half of it mashed to atoms, the brains scattering in all directions and he being instantly killed.
