Page 2:4 - MARRIED - On the 7th inst by the Rev. Dr. GREGORY, Mr. John GRAY of this Village and Miss Mary RUSSELL of Troy.

APRIL 20, 1859

Page 2:6 - DIED - In this Village on Thursday evening, Darius, son of R.D. & N.A. WARNER in the 10th year of his age.

- In this Village on Sunday 17th inst., Cornelia, wife of James K. BATEY, aged 37 years.

APRIL 27, 1859

Page 2:6 - DEATH OF EX GOV. BOUCK - Ex Gov. William C. BOUCK, who has for several months past been suffering from ill health died Tuesday morning, at his residence in Schoharie County. His age was 73 years & 3 months.

MAY 4, 1859

Page 2:3 - HORRIBLE MURDER AT SAND LAKE - A murder occurred in the Town of Sand Lake about 14 miles from Troy on Sunday. An old man, named John BELDING, beat out his daughter Christina's brains with a hammer. He was laboring under a fit of insanity and imagined that his daughter was possessed of a devil. The murdered girl was about 19 years of age. BELDING was brought to Troy and is now in jail. His case will probably be considered by the Grand Jury now in session.

Page 3:1 - DIED - In this Village on Thursday morning last, Ransom W., infant son of Hiram R. & Eunice HOGLE, age 1 yr & 2 mos.

MAY 11, 1859

Page 2:5 - A young man named John LIVINGSTON was drowned at the State Dam Green Island, Sunday morning by the upsetting of a boat in which he was. Although efforts were being made up to last evening, his body has not been recovered.

Page 2:6 - MARRIED - On Tuesday May 10, 1859 at Cambridge, Washington Co. Ny by Rev. Mr. _____, Mr. Elijah R. BROWN of this Village and Miss Laura HOUSE of the former place.

DIED - On the 3d inst. in Rahway, N.J. Mary B. ALLEN daughter of Nehemiah FINCH of this Village, age 27 yrs.
