Page 2:6 - On the same day by the same, Mr. John C. BEAUDOIN of Haverstraw to Miss Alexandrina DINGWALL of this place.

DIED - In this Village on the 11th inst. Lydia A.G. WASHBURN, age 72 years.

JULY 20, 1859

MARRIED - In Troy on Wednesday 13th inst by Rev. Duncan KENNEDY, DD, Rev. Cona OSBORN, Pastor of the Baptist Church of this Village and Miss Evanette E. daughter of Z. E. FORBES Esq. of the former place.

JULY 27, 1859

Page 2:6 - MARRIED - In this Village on Thursday 21st inst. by Rev. Mr. FENNELLY, Mr. John PHELAN of Albany and Miss B.L. McQUADE, niece of Hon. Jas. BRADY.

DIED - In this Village on the 21st inst. George K., only son of George K. & Millet E. MONTGOMERY, age 1 yr 1 mo & 22 dys.

- In Watervliet on Sunday 24th inst. Stephen, son of Henry CRAMER, age 21 yrs 4 mos. & 13 dys.

AUGUST 3, 1859

Page 2:3 - A horrible murder was committed in the adjoining Town of Niskayuna, on Sunday afternoon. Robert BOHANNA was beaten to death by a club by the hands of his son Nicholas, a young man of ^{about} 24 years of age. The deed was witnessed by two of the neighbors, who gave the alarm and the parricide was arrested and taken to Schenectady, where he was lodged in jail. He does not appear to realize the extent or nature of the crime and talks of it with perfect composure. He is said to be insane.

AUGUST 17, 1859

Page 2:3 - CORONER'S INQUEST - Coroner WITBECK held an inquest upon the body of Jas. DOYLE, who died in the lower part of the village on Thursday afternoon last. The verdict was one of death from excessive intemperance.

Also on Sunday Coroner W. held an inquest upon the body of Thomas D. SHIELDS, a lad of about five years of age, who was drowned in the River near the foot of Mansion St., in the First Ward.

On Monday, likewise, he was called to hold an inquest upon the body of James F. CHEW, a colored boy, aged 13 years who was drowned while in bathing off Starbuck's Island. Verdict - accidental drowning.
