DECEMBER 7, 1859

Page 2:1 - EXECUTION OF BROWN - John BROWN was executed at Charlestown on Friday morning last. An immense military display was made on the occasion. His body in charge of his wife, passed through Troy Monday, on its way to North Elba, Essex County, where his funeral will take place on Thursday.

Page 2:4 - DROWNED - A lad about four years old, son of Mr. James DOUGLAS, residing on Fourth St. in the Fourth Ward, was drowned by falling into a cistern in the yard of Otis WOOD adjoining, on Wed. afternoon last.

Page 2:6 - MARRIED - In this Village November 1st by Rev. E. STOVER, Mr. Henry CLAYTON & Mrs. Christopher PARTRIDGE, both of West Troy.

DIED - In Watervliet on the 5th inst. Dorothy, daughter of Henry A. LANSING. Relatives & friends of the family are invited to attend her funeral at the residence of her father this (Wed) afternoon at 1 o'clock.

DECEMBER 14, 1859

Page 2:3 - DEATH OF AN OLD CITIZEN - Asa GARDNER, one of the oldest residents and merchants in Troy, died on Sunday at the Marshal Infirmary. Mr. G. was at one time the heaviest crockery dealer in Troy.

Page 2:4 - A woman named Mary GLEASON, residing in this Village is supposed to have been accidentall drowned or murdered by being pushed in the River on Wed. night last. She was last seen about 7 o'clock on the Bridge leading from Troy to Green Island, and her shawl was subsequently found on the bank of the River just north of the Bridge.

Page 2:6 - DIED - In Cohoes on the 6th inst. Isaac FONDA in the 80th year of his age.

DECEMBER 21, 1859

Page 2:4 - KILLED - A man named CASSIDY was accidentally killed at Albany on Friday last by a clay bank which he was excavating, falling in upon him.

DECEMBER 28, 1859

Page 2:3 - John QUINN of this Village, on trial in the County Court on charge of bigamy, was on Thursday last, convicted of the same. He has been sentenced to Clinton Prison for three years.

Page 2:6 - MARRIED - In this Village Nov 15, 1859 by Rev. B. HAWLEY, Mr. Charles SEEDEE(blurred) of Watervliet & Mary HILL of West Troy.

Page 3:1 - DIED - In this Village on Monday 26th inst., Elizabeth, wife of Simon FORT, age 68 years. Funeral services in North R.D. Church Thursday at 2 o'clock P.M. Friends of the family are invited to attend.
