Page 3:1 - DIED - In this Village on the 21st^{Inst} Nathan C. DAYTON in the 44th year of his age.

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - In this Village December 12, 1859 by Rev. G.L. ROOF, Mr. Edward Walter BITELY & Miss Mary Elizabeth CLARK both of this place.

JANUARY 18, 1860

Page 2:3 - DEAD: S.M. PARKE, the well-known auctioneer, of Albany died very suddenly in that City on Thursday evening last.

Page 2:6 - DIED - In this Village on Tuesday evening January 10, 1860 Mrs. Ann DUFFY, age 61 years.

Page 2:3 - MURDER AT COHOES - Coroner WITBECK of this Village, was called upon Thursday last, to hold an inquest on the body of Mrs. Bridget CAROLAN, who was found dead in her residence in "Muslin de Laine Block, Cohoes". From the testimony taken on the inquest it appears that the deceased came to her death from violence inflicted upon her by one John MEGANS, of the same place, a few days previous and the jury returned a verdict to that effect. Immediately after the rendition of the verdict, a warrant was placed in the hands of an officer for the arrest of the perpetrator of the deed, but by mistake his brother was arrested and the guilty one escaped. P.S. Since the above was in type, we have been informed that MEGANS was arrested in Utica at 4 o'clock in the afternoon, and was lodged in the Albany Jail yesterday.

Page 2:4 - ANOTHER DEATH - Mrs. TILLEY, of Grafton, who was injured in the recent accident of the Hudson River Railroad Company, died in New York, last Wednesday evening.

Page 3:1 - DIED - In this Village on Thursday evening, Jan. 26th Mrs. Eugenia Philena ROUSSEAU, wife of Charles D. ROUSSEAU, and only daughter of the late Andrew MENEELY, age 22 years.
