Page 2:2 - Father MCCLOSKEY, Pastor of St. John's(R.C.) Church Albany died Sunday morning last of dropsey. He was greatly beloved by his own parishioners and respected by all who knew him.

- An elderly man named John FERGUSON, a workmen in the woolen mills of James ROY & Co., in the First Ward, fell dead in an apoplectic fit, in the factory, on Friday morning last. Coroner WITBECK held an inquest on the body.

Page 2:3 - DEAD - Thomas GOLDWAITE, a member of Capt. BLANCHARD's Company in the Third Regiment New York State V. died of typhoid fever at Fort McHenry, Maryland on Friday last. GOLDWAITE was an old Albany fireman, & for several years before the breaking out of the war, was connected with Tivoli Hose Company, - being familiarly known as "Cherry". He will be recollected by many of the West Troy Fire Department. He was an agreeable companion, a noble fireman, and we doubt not, a brave soldier. His remains reached Albany yesterday, and his funeral took place from the residence of his mother yesterday afternoon.
