Page 2:3 - MURDER - Mrs. Ann HARTY residing on Ida Hill, Troy, was killed by her husband on Thursday night last. Both the parties were intemperate and frequently quarreled The murderer is in custody.

Page 2:4 DECEASE OF AN OLD PRINTER - On Saturday David H. REINS the oldest printer in the city of New York, died at the residence of his son-in-law, in Westchester County at the advanced age of 80 years. The Commercial says of him, "In 1809 in company with the late George MATHER, and several others, all we believe now deceased, he organized the present New York Typeographical Society, the first meeting of which was held the fourth of July of that year when he was elected its Secretary, &he has always held a position of President and was always one of its most active working members while his health and strength permitted him. Mr. REINS was a brother-in-law of the late Samuel WOODWORTH, the 'printer poet'. Both of them worked as jorneymen together in the office of the New York Columbian while it was under the editorial management of the late Charles HOLT, and both were engaged as partners in the publication of a literary journal issued about the close of the last war. Mr. REINS took part in that contest, being a member of an artillery company, organized by the printers, which was employed in garrisoning defenses of the harbor, and of which the late Charles WILEY and Cornelius VAN WINKLE, then the leading employing printers of this city were officers."
