Page 2:6 - DIED - In Troy on Saturday August 9th, Edward W. FREE, age 50 years & 6 months.

Page 2:3 - The remains of Lt. Jas. KINNEAR, of the 79th New York V., ex-chief engineer of the Albany Fire Department, who was killed in the Battle on James Island, a few weeks since, reached that City Saturday evening, & his funeral took place Sunday afternoon, with an imposing demonstration of military and firemen.

Page 2:5 - DIED - In this Village on Wednesday 13th inst., Caroline only daughter of Ervin & Catherine CASE, age nine months.

Page 2:3 - SUICIDE - On Saturday a German named Clemeus DOHMANN, shot himself at a house in the Town of Bethlehem, about four miles from Albany. DOHMANN is represented as being an intemperate man. He went into an out-house, where he took a gun, placed the muzzle under his chin, and snapping the trigger with his foot, the contents passed up through the top of his head. He died instantly.

Page 2:4 - TERRIBLE ACCIDENT - A CHILD SCALDED TO DEATH - On Sunday afternoon last, a terrible accident occurred at Cohoes, resulting in the almost instant death of a child, aged about one year, son of Mr. Adam McCLELLAN, of that Village. The child was playing near a stove, when he accidentally upset a large kettle of boiling water, which fell on him, burning him terribly. He died in a few hours. Coroner WITBECK was summoned and held an inquest, the jury rendering a verdict in accordance with the above facts. Mr. McCLELLAN is a very worthy citizen, and deserves the sympathy of the community in which he lives in his bereavement.

SAD ACCIDENT - An accident occurred on River Street, Troy, a little south of WIER's Hotel, Monday evening, which resulted in the instant death of an elderly man, named William CARR a resident of Hoosick St. The deceased was riding on one of Tracey's beer wagons, when a large barrel of ale, on which he was sitting, rolled off, from the jolting of the wagon carrying him with it, and falling on him. When picked up, it was found that life was extinct. He was conveyed to his residence on Hoosick St.
